Change Request # CR0000 Printing linked serial numbers on the Order & Pick Ticket

Description of Change

ACMECO is using the Dynamics GP manufacturing serial-lot linking functionality to tie component serial numbers to the finished item serial numbers. The Sales Order and Picking Ticket reports show the serial number for the sold item, but not the serialized components within the assembly. ACMECO needs to print the item numbers and serial numbers for the components within the finished item.

The process that prepares the Sales Order and Pick Ticket for printing will be modified to read the serial-lot linking information from GP Manufacturing so that each serial on the sales order will then be followed by the first-level linked components.

The modification will work with the existing Dynamics GP Order and Pick Ticket report. A rough mock-up is shown below. The made item (100XLG) appears on the sales line. It is followed by the serial number used to fulfill that line quantity, then below that will follow all of the serial numbered components.

This modification will work only for Sales ORDERS printed from Sales Transaction Entry. It will not work for other document types, or if the orders are printed in a Batch, or from the Print Sales Documents window. It will work for posted documents (reprinting a Order once it has been transferred to an Invoice). It does not require any special changes to the existing Order or Picking Ticket reports.
